

### **Course Content:**

The Practical Nursing program at South Florida Healthcare Institute prepares an individual to participate in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of nursing care in hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, home health care, and community-based settings. Students are introduced to the clinical area early in the program. Theory and clinical procedures are integrated to reinforce learning. Our program includes classroom theory, laboratory experiences, and supervised clinical experiences with clear program learning outcomes.

A diploma is issued at the successful completion of the program in accordance with the Florida Department of Education. Graduates are entitled to take the NCLEX-PN licensure examination. The Florida Board of Nursing will issue a license to those who pass the examination.

- 18 Years of Age or Older
- High School or GED
- Meet with Nursing Program Director
- Complete a Practical Nursing Application Packet
- Pass the HESI Entrance Exam with a 70%
- Clearance on FDLE Level II Background Check
- Negative Drug Test Results
- Immunizations and Physical Exam

Students who graduated from South Florida Healthcare Institute's Nursing Assistant (CNA), Phlebotomy Technician (CPT), or Medical Assistant (CCMA) programs, are eligible to receive \$500 off their Practical Nursing tuition.

### **Immunizations:**

- MMR Vaccine Series (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) (X2) or Titer
- Hepatitis B Vaccine Series (X3) or Titer or Authorized Declination Form
- Varicella Vaccine (X2) or Titer
- Influenza Vaccine (Flu Shot)

Uniforms: Uniforms must be purchased by the student.

## **Industry Certification & State Credential Exams:**

Students will be prepared to take the NCLEX-PN licensure examination upon successful completion of the Practical Nursing program. Exam costs are additional, and at the expense of the student.

**College Credit Transfer:** Upon completion of the program and meeting eligibility requirements, students may articulate into an LPN to RN program at another school that offers that program, with advanced standing.

**Books / Supplies:** Admitted students must purchase their own books and nursing kits. This is not included in the tuition fees. Students will receive their nursing kits, books, and uniform, at their scheduled mandatory orientation.
