- Holder of a BLS Provider card for a minimum of 2 years prior to the course.

Take the James Street exit off I-5 in the downtown area of Seattle. Turn up the hill (east) on James Street. (Left from I-5 S and Right from I-5 N) Turn right (south) on Ninth Avenue and go two blocks. Harborview's Research & Training Building is on the corner of Ninth Avenue and Alder Street.

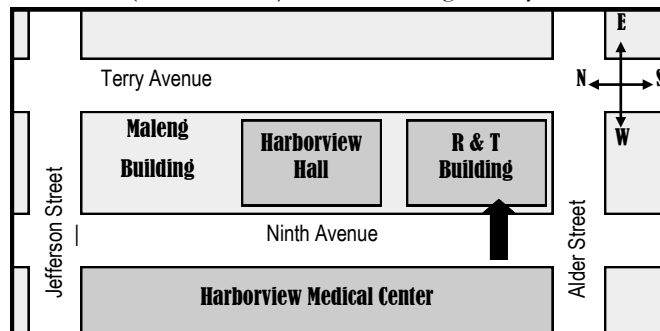

Course Completion

- Complete the AHA BLS Instructor Essentials Course. **The AHA BLS Instructor Essentials Course MUST be completed prior to the BLS Instructor Course and certificate of completion presented as admittance to the course. Participants who arrive without their certificate WILL NOT be able to participate in the Instructor Course.** This computer based program takes approximately 2 hours to complete. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact our office at 206-744-5027.
- Attend a one-day 8 hour BLS Instructor Course.
- Achieve a minimum score of 84% on the 25-question written provider exam.
- Achieve a minimum score of 84% on the 25-question written instructor exam.
- Demonstrate **Strong** Performance of **2015 GUIDELINE** psychomotor skills for:
 - One and two-rescuer CPR, Adult, Infant, and Child
 - Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
 - Obstructed Airway, Conscious and Unconscious Adult, Infant, and Child
 - Rescue Breathing, Adult, Infant, and Child
 - Use of a Bag Mask on Adult, Infant, and Child.
- Acceptable presentation of mini-teaching demonstration topic.
- Successful observation of first class new instructor teaches. Observation will be conducted by a Training Center Faculty.
- Registration on the AHA Instructor Network.

Please Note:

This course does not provide a Provider skill review. It is expected that Instructor Candidates demonstrate exceptional skills during the course. This course is designed with a focus on teaching skills.
