In an effort to maintain social distancing and minimize off-the-unit time, TJUH will implement a new procedure for any staff requiring the American Heart Association in-hospital skills verification.

Beginning Monday, July 13, all TJUH clinical staff members will be required to register for a timeslot for the skills verification process. On the JeffSTAT registration page, staff can sign up for a one-hour window during which they will attend the skills verification sessions. Registration for the sessions will close two business days before the session. Staff members will then receive an email with a specific appointment time within the one-hour block for which they registered.

About the Appointments

The duration of the appointment is 15 minutes. If you arrive greater than five minutes late for your appointment, you will not be permitted to complete the verification, and your department will be billed a \$50 “no show” fee. If you arrive without having completed the online portion, you will not be permitted to test and will incur the “no show” fee.
