



## About Our EMT Program

The course is designed to provide classroom knowledge and hands-on experience that will prepare students to administer care in emergency situations. The program covers anatomy and physiology, initial patient survey and triage, airway management, oxygen therapy, and treatment of bleeding, shock, cardiac arrest, automated external defibrillation, fractures, spinal injuries, and other medical emergencies.

EMT-Basic training consists of three areas of coursework and hands-on experience designed to prepare students to administer care in emergency situations.



**The Didactic Portion:** This Didactic portion of the course provides students with the required theoretical knowledge and foundation of the basic program. This is a classroom-based through lecture, case scenario presentation, and discussion during the regularly scheduled class session. The students will also complete quizzes and other assignments through the Jones and Bartlett Navigation Program.

**Psychomotor Portion:** This is the hands-on portion of the EMT-Basic course. The Psychomotor Portion of the course is completed during your regularly scheduled class sessions. The Skills Testing performed by Roxell EMT instructors are your NREMT Psychomotor Skills Test.

**Clinical Internship:** The clinical internship is one of the most unique and interesting parts of the program. You finally get to ride on an ambulance and attend clinical rotation in the Emergency Department. This is where you get real-world experience and hands-on experiences. Students will be required to attend 48 hours in an EMS setting These are scheduled through approved Roxell EMT affiliated EMS and hospitals. Clinical dates and time vary.

- 18 years or older
- High School Diploma, GED, or official transcript



## Available Course Formats

### Hybrid Course

- 12-Weeks Program
- Roxell EMT is using a combination of web-based online activity, video, and self-study to replace a portion of traditional face-to-face instruction.
- Classes are mostly online. Face-to-Face one day a week from 930am to 5pm
- You are required to have 48hours of Ambulance clinical time and 8-hours of Emergency room rotation.
- Clinical rotations will be completed with approved Roxell EMT partners.

### Traditional Classroom Course

- 12-Weeks Program
- Classes are held every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 930am till 4:30pm for the first 7 weeks.
- Clinical Follows the next 4 weeks but you are required to have 48hours of Ambulance clinical time and 8-hours of Emergency Room rotation.
- Clinical rotations will be completed with approved Roxell EMT partners.
- The final week you will return to class for final lecture, exam, and graduation.
- A 12-Week Program

### Nationwide Course

- Our Nationwide Online EMT-B program is self-paced and open enrollment.
- The only restriction for this program is that the student must complete all portions of the program within SIX months from the enrollment date.
- **Psychomotor portion** of the program consists of three (3) days, BLS/CPR courses, medical/trauma skills practices, and tests performed in Houston, totaling 24 hours of Psychomotor skills sessions. Several schedules are available.
- **Clinical:** 48-hours of ambulance clinical rotation and 8-hours of emergency room rotation is required.
- You may complete your clinical internship in your home state, a clinical contract must be submitted and approved by Roxell EMT.



## **Tuition and payment arrangements**

Cost of the Program: 1499.

Payment arrangements are available as follows:

- Tier 1- student paid in full = \$1499
- Tier 2 - Student pays \$800, followed by three payments of \$283
- Tier 3 - Students pay \$500, followed by six payments of \$209
