



## PHLEBOTOMY

<b>Length of Course:</b>	<p><u>Online:</u> Self-Paced Instruction (8 -12 weeks) <u>Open Lab Sessions:</u> 40 hours (see open lab schedule for days &amp; times) <i>Every student must complete 40 hours on campus during open lab sessions. Sessions are offered during the day and evening, and occasionally a Saturday. These sessions will provide a hands-on approach to the learning experience. You will be expected to actively participate in venipunctures during these sessions.</i> <u>Clinical Externship:</u> 40 hours completed at a local lab or hospital <i>You may be required to have a criminal background check and a drug screening prior to externship. These screenings will be at the student's expense.</i></p>
<b>Total hours:</b>	148 hours
<b>Program Description:</b>	<p>This ONLINE SELF-PACED hybrid course is designed to instruct and develop the skills of the medical professional in the science of venipuncture. The curriculum is designed to meet the standards of the National Healthcareer Association, a national certifying agency of Phlebotomy Technicians. The student will receive instruction in identifying equipment and supplies used to obtain a routine venous specimen, urinalysis, blood smears, and capillary puncture. The student will also receive <u>hands-on experience</u> during open lab sessions. Upon successful completion of this course, the participant will be able to describe the 25 steps used for a proper venipuncture and list the anti-coagulants used, order of tube draw, and color-coding recognized with each type of specimen collection. The student will also receive a four hour AIDS completion certificate &amp; certified in CPR (BLS for Healthcare Providers), as well as become knowledgeable in OSHA standards as applicable to the laboratory and healthcare setting.</p>
<b>Admission Requirements:</b>	High School diploma or equivalent
<b>Online Learning:</b>	To be successful academically, online students must be able to navigate & search the internet, use email, attach and upload documents, download & save documents, and have access to and use Microsoft Word, Excel, & PowerPoint.
